


# From Rancho PTA



### RECYCLING

Hello Rancho Recyclers!

We just wanted to say that the first few weeks of school have been totally awesome. We have recycled lots of cans and bottles! What this means to you is that we have already earned over \$200.00 which will be used for many important things at our school such as new computers and funding for fun family events.

Every time a Rancho Roadrunner recycles at our school they should get a warm and fuzzy feeling because not only do they support our school but they are helping our environment!

Did you know that:

~Americans throw away 2.5 million plastic bottles every hour? Plastics are a major source of environmental pollution and are much easier to recycle than you might think.

~On average, one person uses up to two pine trees worth of paper each year.

**Recycling helps Solve the Landfill Problem:** Lots of our garbage is disposed of in landfills. But we're producing trash at an overwhelming rate. We're already running out of landfill space. This crisis is severest in cities and suburbs, where the problem is so pressing that landfills are slowly creeping closer to crowded human settlements. This makes us vulnerable to disease.

Recycling helps To Prevent Water Pollution: Untreated waste in our landfills leads to problems when contaminants seep down to lower levels of the soil. Eventually they reach the groundwater and pollute it. Sometimes we try to get rid of our trash by dumping waste in our oceans, with devastating results for our marine life.

As we continue our recycling drive this year we would like you to help us by doing the following things when setting aside your recycling for Friday:

#### Plastic bottles, aluminum cans, ink and toner cartridges

We are accepting the following items as recycling donations: plastic bottles, aluminum cans, used toner and ink cartridges through the Cartridges for Kids program.

#### Sort and separate

It would be a **BIG** help if you could sort and separate your aluminum and plastic and remove bottle caps. Please do your best to make sure there are no non-recyclable items in the bags.

#### **Saturday Drop-Off**

There will be a recycling drop-off set up at the school from 9:00-11:00am on the second Saturday of each month. Please tell all of your friends and neighbors as well.

The Rancho PTA will be handing out special prizes for Roadrunners who drop off separated recycling and to those classes who recycle the most, so keep up the good work!
